PRAYER POINTS

- Praise God that Jesus stands before the Father as our advocate when we sin.
- Praise Jesus that He is a King who is full of grace and that we can confidently appeal to Him for ourselves and for others.
- Pray that God would grant us wisdom to recognise Jesus and give Him proper praise.
- Pray for those living like Nabal, that they would sober up, be convicted of sin, and run to King Jesus for refuge before He returns.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Are there things that we ought to yield to King Jesus but hold back as “mine”? (Think possessions, choices, plans, time, relationships, etc.) How does Jesus’ treatment of us help and inspire us to respond rightly to Him?
2. Nabal and Abigail meet very different ends in the passage, pointing to the only two destinations facing every person. How should that stark contrast cause us to live now?
3. We saw last week that Christians, like Christ, are to repay evil with good. How can we stop ourselves and each other when, like David, we are heading towards revenge rather than grace?
