PRAYER POINTS

SPACE FOR YOUR NOTES ON MATTHEW 3:13-17

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. The birth, baptism, and burial of Jesus all show how completely he came to share in our sin and death in order to save us. How does Jesus drawing near to us in these ways move us to love and praise him?
2. As Jesus walks in God's way, he has both the help of the Spirit and the approving joy of his Father. As we seek to walk in God's ways, how does the Spirit help us, and how can we be encouraged by knowing the Father is pleased with us?
3. Matthew wants us to see that Jesus perfectly fulfils all the promises and patterns of God's salvation given in the Old Testament. Look again at these five verses and try to identify every OT promise or pattern that Jesus is fulfilling.
