- 2) Read v 5-7 In what ways could God say to you, that he hasn't grabbed glory for Himself but in grace has journeyed with you?
- 3) In what ways do we enjoy rest (v10) from our enemies as those who belong to Christ's Kingdom now? In what ways is there more rest to come?
- 4) David desendants did reign, and Solomon built the temple, how do we know these promises point beyond Solomon and sons?
- 5) How should we respond to the awesome things God promises here, and to the awesome one who is promised here?

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
