

PRAYER POINTS

- Thank God for specific moments of undeserved kindness he has shown you, this year and at the cross.
- Confess your sins to God, trusting that he blesses those who come to him empty-handed.
- Pray for someone you long to see turn to Christ, that this would be their day of grace.
- Ask God to make us into a church which builds his house gladly, not anxiously, until the day Jesus returns.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. Recall a day in your life you could circle in your calendar as a day of God's grace (whether your conversion or a moment later in your Christian life). Why was it so significant for you?
2. How does the truth that sin has tainted every aspect of people affect how we view others? Does conversion change the pervasive impact of sin in the Christian?
3. What difference does it make to build God's house (i.e. obey him and work for his kingdom to come) depending on God's grace instead of working to earn it?
4. Summarise the message of the book of Haggai:
 - a. In as many words as you'd like.
 - b. In 3 sentences.
 - c. In 1 sentence
