 3. How can we have each other's backs as brothers and sisters in Christ? (Be practical and specific – how will you do that this week?)
 4. If we know people are rejecting Jesus' grace and actively rebelling against Him, how should we respond?
 5. In which situations are you being called right now to be strong in the Lord as you trust that He will do what is good in His eyes?
